HOW CAN I PREPARE FOR THE NIGHT SKY VIEWING?

- Familiarize yourself with the *Star Walk*, *Sky Safari* or your preferred app.
- Allow your eyes to get accustomed to the dark prior to the start time.
- Set your chosen app to *Night Mode* (red screen) and dim your computer too.
