Presentation & Winter Uniform

- Navy trousers or navy shorts worn with navy socks with red and white stripes
- Belt (black leather) must be worn with trousers or shorts with belt loops
- White long sleeve shirt with logo (formal/winter shirt must be tucked in and worn with the tie)
- School Tie
- Navy blue V neck jumper (with logo)
- Navy blue blazer (Yrs. 7-12 only)
- Navy/maroon tunic (F Yr.6) or navy/maroon skirt (Yr.5 12) worn with either the navy socks with red and white stripe (Yrs 7-12), long navy socks (F-Yr.6) or navy blue tights
- Winter parka (F Yr.6 only)

Summer – Terms 1 & 4

- Navy shorts or navy trousers worn with navy socks with red & white stripe
- White short sleeve shirt with logo (the summer shirt is cropped and may be worn untucked. No tie with summer shirt)
- Navy blue V neck jumper (with logo)
- Navy blue blazer Yrs. 7-12
- Navy/maroon/white check summer dress worn with short white socks

P - 12 Sport Uniform

- House top
- White sports sock with red & blue stripe or logo
- Navy track suit pants or shorts
- Rugby Top with logo (compulsory)
- CGS waterproof sports jacket (optional)

Other Uniform items

- School bag and Sports bag
- Sun hat

- Library bag
- Navy gloves, scarf, beanie (Optional winter only. Not to be worn during class)

Phase out period for old uniform items

- Junior school windcheater to be replaced by the Rugby top by Jan 2023
- Grey school pants/shorts to be replaced by Navy school pants/shorts by Jan 2025

- It is an expectation that the uniform be worn correctly and with pride
- Black leather lace-up formal school shoes or black leather buckle shoes, heel not to exceed 3cm. Foundation to Yr. 2 lace-up or Velcro fastening is acceptable (No Velcro for students from Year 3)
- Hats must be worn outdoors for Foundation to Year 12 during Terms 1 and 4
- Students have the discretion to wear their choice of winter or summer uniform except from the first school day in May to the last day of Term 3 when winter uniform must be worn. There should be no mixing of uniform items between summer and winter uniform.
- Items from the sport uniform must NOT be worn with the summer or winter uniform
- The blazer must be worn to and from school, on excursions and when representing the School. On very hot days, the Head of Senior School will give permission for students to remove their blazers, however, students will be required to carry blazers home on hot days so they can be worn to school the next morning. Jumpers can be worn under the blazer but must not be worn as the outer garment when commuting to and from school, when on excursions or when representing the school.
- Scarves, parkas, gloves, rain jackets and beanies must not be worn in the classroom. These are outdoor wear only.
- All headwear must be navy blue in colour. This includes beanies, Hijabs & Turbans.
- Undergarments i.e. T Shirts or long sleeve tops must not be visible.
